His work is included in the permanent collections of the Corcoran Art Gallery, Washington D.C.; the Whitney Museum of American Art, New York, NY; The Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York, NY; Hammer Museum, University of California, Los Angeles, CA; San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, San Francisco, CA among others.

## Museo de Arte de Ponce Puerto Rican Art Collection Presentation and Discussion



The Museo de Arte de Ponce houses some of the most important works by Puerto Rican artists. This collection is composed by objects, ranging from the eighteenth century to today, from artists born in Puerto Rico, living in Puerto Rico, or of Puerto Rican descent, including José Campeche, Zilia Sánchez and Arnaldo Roche.

## Performances by Broadway Tony Award-winning artists including Freestyle Love Supreme



Before *In the Heights* and before *Hamilton*, there was *Freestyle Love Supreme*. Created by Lin-Manuel Miranda, this Tony Award-winning and Grammy-nominated experience is a freestyle (hence the name), improvisational, hip-hop comedy show. Every night the performers take suggestions from the audience and spin them into instantaneous riffs and full-length musical numbers.

## **About the Museo de Arte de Ponce**

The Museo de Arte de Ponce is a non-profit organization, recognized worldwide as an important center of European, Puerto Rican, and Latin American art in America, and continues to offer its visitors a rich panorama of Western art, from the end of the Middle Ages to the dawn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. Two strengths of the collection are European and Puerto Rican art works.

The Museo de Arte de Ponce was founded by Luis A. Ferré (1904-2003), a Puerto Rican philanthropist, entrepreneur and future governor of Puerto Rico who felt passionately about culture and education. Ferré had the vision of bringing outstanding examples of European art to the island. Unlike other founders, who created museums out of personal collections, Ferré started buying for the institution from the outset by establishing first The Luis A. Foundation in 1957.

The Museum opened its doors to the public on January 3, 1959, in a colonial house in Ponce, Ferré's hometown and a center of cultural life during the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. The current building was inaugurated on December 28, 1965, and was designed by American Architect Edward Durell Stone, who is acclaimed for projects such as MOMA in New York and the Kennedy Center in Washington DC. Both the building and its gardens are recognized as landmark designs in Puerto Rico's architectural heritage. When the Museum opened, the collection consisted of 71 paintings; these have been added to over the years, both before and after Ferré's death, and today they number approximately 4,000 artworks.
